Norfolk & Norwich Naturalist's Society publish the latest Norfolk Bird and Mammal Report

The 2019 Bird and Mammal Report is now available from the Norfolk and Norwich Naturalist's Society (NNNS) website shop. <http://norfolknaturalists.org.uk/wp/shop/> Supplied free to members of the Society anyone with an interest in wildlife can purchase the 244 page volume for £12

Within the pages are listed the highlights of the birds seen during the year including the account of finding a new bird never seen in Norfolk before; an Upland Sandpiper. This is a bird that breeds in Canada and the Northern USA and winters in the East to central region of South America.

As you would expect mammals don't go unmentioned either with articles on the establishment of two invasive deer species in Norfolk: Reeve's Muntjac and Chinese Water Deer and a paper examining the possible link between the decrease in Harbour Porpoise numbers and the increase in Norfolk's Grey Seal population.

The report has some impressive photography displayed within its pages from the Short-Eared Owl on the front cover to the Reeve's Muntjac on the back cover.

Tony Leech, Chair of the Publications Committee of the NNNS, says "This is a wonderful publication; our best yet. Anyone who has any interest in Norfolk's wildlife should have it on their bookshelf"
